

2021 EDITION OF LIVRE PARIS CANCELLED

Given the uncertain prospects over coming months, and as the current health measures do not allow us to organise a public event of this scale under satisfactory conditions, the French Publishers Association (SNE), in agreement with Reed Expositions France, regrets to announce the cancellation of the 2021 edition of Livre Paris.

Livre Paris 2021, initially scheduled for March, had been postponed until the end of May because of the evolving nature of the COVID-19 epidemic.

It was ultimately decided to cancel this year's show as it was no longer conceivable to gather thousands of people - exhibitors, publishers, authors, speakers, councils and ministries, plus partners from over 50 countries - on a later date in the autumn.

The many exhibitors who had paid to exhibit at the 2021 edition will be reimbursed for all the sums already paid.

We would like to thank everyone who had expressed their passion and determination to see Livre Paris held this year, through their messages and commitment and the lending of their support.

The French Publishers Association would stress that despite this cancellation and today's difficult situation, the promotion of books and of reading will continue through other channels. 2022 will bring a new event to celebrate the wonder of books!
